


AKAGERA KIDS' END OF FIRST TERM REPORT

All the children attended school, and their results are satisfactory. And their life conditions are generally good as remarkable hereafter:




1. Fabrice Ndayishimiye

2. David Iradukunda




He was ranked the 9th of 32 Primary 2 students with 70.7%, up from the 47th position last year. He now lives at Fabrice's family because their parents ran away.






4. Jean Claude Niyonsenga

He was ranked the 14th of 32 Primary 2 students with 61.7%, up from the 53rd position last year. He did much effort.






5. Pacifique Niyonshuti

He was ranked the 20th of 32 Primary 2 students with 56.2%, down from the 14th position last year. He is recovering from his skin condition.




7. Lea Isimbi

He was ranked the 14th of 47 Primary 3 students with 71.5%, up from the 27th position last year. He did some effort.




9. Gloriose Irakoze

She came the 6th of 50 Senior 2 students with 59.0%, up from the 45th position last year. She has done lot of effort, and helps Lea Isimbi with homework.




10. Charite Uwase



She came the 25th of 48 Primary 4 students with 38.5%, down from the 18th position last year. She has just joined the program.




11. Aline Muhimpundu
